

In 2017 we celebrate 100 years of Lions Club International. Today, the International Association of Lions Clubs is the largest humanitarian organisation in the world, with more than 1,400,000 members in more than 46,000 clubs in 210 countries and geographic regions. The organisation was founded by Melvin Jones, a businessman from Chicago. The Lions help and serve their local communities, as well as globally, and they do what they do with great pleasure:

WHERE THERE IS A NEED, THE LIONS ARE THERE.

They are mostly known for their successful campaigns in helping the visually impaired and the blind, as well as helping senior citizens, and even providing assistance during natural disasters. Lions Club International is the only non-governmental humanitarian organisation with offices within the United Nations (UN) and the World Health Organisation (WHO).

The first Lions Club in Croatia was founded in Dubrovnik (Sveti Vlaho LC) on October 25, 1990. Today, there are 57 registered Lions Clubs and 7 Leo Clubs (for young members) with a total of 1,300 members who are active in four regions.

The most significant projects and campaigns of the Croatian Lions include: Yacht Regatta Against Drugs, Peace Poster, Grand Prix music competition for young Lions, Photography Competition, Young Members Exchange, Youth Camp, and numerous other humanitarian campaigns.

During the past 26 years, the Croatian Lions have raised several million euros with their campaigns. These funds were used for the most relevant humanitarian purposes in our homeland.
